
There are three ways to object, each option and instructions on how to do so are detailed below.

#### Step 2: Scroll down to 'Policy PP9: North-East Colchester':




### Step 3: Click the 'Comments' box:






**Step 5:** Identify you will be objecting by clicking 'Object':




